1. On behalf of the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Bathinda, Corporation Engineer, Municipal Corporation, Bathinda invites bids from eligible bidders for the Project/Work(s) detailed in the following table. The bidders may submit bids for any or all of the following Project/Work(s):

- iii. Date & time of opening of Technical Bid : 25.09.2026 up to 11.00 AM

4. The Bidding Documents can be down loaded from website: www.eproc.punjab.gov.in. The document downloaded from website should not be tampered, and if any such tampering is detected before or after the opening of bids, the bidder shall be debarred for a period of 6 months.
5. The bidders should have the necessary Portal enrolment with his/her own Digital Signature Certificate (DSC).
6. The bidders should keep checking the website for any **addenda/corrigenda** to the notice/bidding documents till the date of on-line submission of bids, and the bidder should incorporate the same in his bid documents.
7. The cost of the bidding documents (non-refundable) shall be paid online through Net Banking/NEFT/RTGS at portal www.eproc.punjab.gov.in.
8. Bid Security/Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of the amount specified for the Project/Work(s) in the table above shall be paid online through Net Banking/NEFT/RTGS at portal www.eproc.punjab.gov.in.

Or As per latest notification/amendment dated 2.12.2025 of Punjab Govt. in Punjab Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2022 which is reproduced as.

Bid submission: "Bid Security and tender fee may be obtained in the form of insurance surety bonds, or bank guarantee (including e Bank Guarantee) issued or confirmed by any of the Scheduled Banks (as defined in section 2 (c) of the Reserve Bank of India Act 1934 or in the electronic format online (NEFT/RTGS/Internet banking) or any other online mode available on e-procurement portal. Bid security/EMD in the form of insurance surety bond or bank guarantee shall be submitted online only and insurance surety bonds or bank guarantee shall not be accepted in physical form. In case of exemption of Bid Security, the scanned copy of the document in support of exemption will have to be uploaded by the bidder during bid submission. For more information, the bidders shall refer to the instructions provided on the e-Procurement Portal's Website under Bidders Manual Kit.

Further, recognized Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs) and Startups are exempted from payment of Bid Security. Subject to submission of valid registration /Udyam certificate verified by the General Manager, District Industry Centre of the concerned district, confirming the units locations within Punjab and its MSE status or registered Startup with Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Punjab and must

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- submit a Bid Security Declaration accepting that if they withdraw or modify their bids during period of validity, they will be suspended for the time specified in the tender documents"
- "(c) Bid Security and tender fee may be obtained in the form of insurance surety bonds, or bank guarantee (including e Bank Guarantee) issued or confirmed by any of the Scheduled Banks (as defined in section 2 (e) of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 or in the electronic format online (NEFT/RTGS/Internet banking) or any other online mode available on e-procurement portal. Bid security/EMD in the form of insurance surety bond or bank guarantee shall be submitted online only and insurance surety bonds or bank guarantee shall not be accepted in physical form.
- (d) Further, recognized Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs) and Startups (recognized by the Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Punjab) are exempted from payment of Bid Security, subject to submission of valid registration or Udyam certificate verified by the General Manager, District Industries Centre of the concerned district, confirming the units locations of units within Punjab and its MSE status or registered Startup with the Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Punjab and must submit a Bid Security Declaration accepting that if they withdraw or modify their bids during period of validity, they shall be suspended for the time specified in the tender documents"
9. Bid(s) must be submitted online through an e-portal www.eproc.punjab.gov.in before the time specified in the table above (as per server clock). The department does not take any responsibility for the delay caused due to non-availability of internet connection or network traffic jam etc. for online bids.
 10. Bid documents consisting of qualification information and eligibility criterion of bidders, plans, specifications, drawings, the bill of quantities of the various classes of work to be done and the set of terms & conditions of contract to be complied with by the Contractor can be seen on website www.eproc.punjab.gov.in and scanned copies of the required documents and information as per section-2 (Formats & Annexure) should be attached in the Technical Bid as prescribed in the SBD.
 11. Uploaded documents of valid successful bidders will be verified with the original before signing the agreement. The valid successful bidder has to provide the originals to the concerned authority on receipt of such letter, which will be sent through registered post/E-mail/courier.
 12. Standard Bidding Documents (SBD) is not to be uploaded by the bidder. The bidder has to only agree/disagree on the conditions in the SBD. The bidders who disagree on the conditions of SBD, cannot participate in the tender.
 13. Technical Bids will be opened on-line on the day & time as specified in the above table, in the presence of the bidders who wish to attend. If the office happens to be closed on the date of receipt of the bids as specified, the bids will be received and opened on the next working day at the same time and venue.
 14. Bid(s) once submitted online cannot be resubmitted or withdrawn.
 15. Conditional bids and the bids not meeting the qualifying criteria on the date of receipt of bids shall be summarily rejected.
 16. The undersigned has the right to accept or reject any or all bids without assigning any reason.
 17. All the conditions in letter no. CE-2026/71165 dated 01.09.2026 issued by the Chief Engineer, Local Government Department, Punjab will be followed in letter and spirit.
 18. In case of administrative approval cost/final cost of any work is Rs. 10.00 lacs and above, third party Techno Financial Auditors shall be engaged. Deduction @0.75% + applicable GST (or the rate quoted by third party Techno Financial Auditor) whichever is less shall be made from the payments of the contractor. The final payment will be done after technical and financial closure. Corrigendum/Addendum/Corrections, if any will be posted on the website only.
 19. NIT and Terms and conditions have been/uploaded on website (eproc.punjab.gov.in), agencies should note that online tenders should only be submitted at the aforesaid website eproc.punjab.gov.in as per the details/instructions uploaded therein.
 20. NIT, Terms and conditions, NS rate details and specifications can be seen in the office of Municipal Corporation on any working day.
 21. All legal proceedings in connection with the contract shall be subject to the territorial jurisdiction of the civil courts at Bathinda only.
 22. For any other query bidders can contact the undersigned office on any working day.
 23. The rates for payments shall be quoted above or below the CSR rates prevailing on date of tendering and

current premium applicable and amendment issued by Govt. prevailing at the time tendering.

24. The tenders to the L&C Co-Operative Societies and Contractors will be issued and considered only if they produce an enlistment certificate from PWD (B&R) or any valid enlistment with any Govt. Department/ Boards/ Corporation/ Local Govt. of Punjab Govt. or Central Govt. under appropriate Class and Category of work
25. The tender to manufacturers/suppliers/authorized dealers who have successfully completed similar nature of works with satisfactory performance are exempted from above enlistment. However, they are required to meet the all-other conditions of the DNIT.
26. The L&C Co-Operative Societies shall submit its capacity certificate from the concerned authority of Co-Operative department along with tender.
27. The contractor shall not remove any installed material from site of work without prior approval of CMC Bathinda.
28. The Contractor/Firms/ L&C Co-Operative Society must have got EPF code no. and ESIC prior to opening of tenders (As applicable).
29. The L&C Co-Operative Societies will have to submit a financial capacity certificate issued by Registrar, Co-Operative Societies. They will have to submit detail of their ongoing works in all departments. Works more than their financial capacity will not be allotted as directed by Director Local Govt. Punjab vide his letter No. 2123-24 dated 19.1.2021.
30. If the Financial bid quotes more than 25% saving from the estimated cost, the Engineer may ask the bidder to produce detailed analysis for any or all the items to check the viability of rates w.r.t to Construction methodology & workability. After evaluation of price analysis, the ULB may ask the Bidder to give an additional Bank Guarantee of nationalized bank @ 5% of the estimated amount (to remain valid till the time period of the refund of security) so as to protect against financial loss in event of subsequent default by the Bidder for not completing the work etc.
31. The successful bidder is bound to complete the work within stipulated time, in case of any delay / failure, this office shall be free to take action as per SBD / MW-5 / as per Govt. instructions or the relevant tender / Contract agreement/allotment clauses.
32. The contractor shall have to abide by all the terms and conditions of the contract and the Notice Inviting Tenders. He shall execute the works satisfactorily, on time and with good quality. The MC authority shall have the right to suspend business with him for any period, debar him-or-remove his name from the list of approved contractors after issue of show cause notice. Decision of the Commissioner, MCB shall be final and binding on the contractor.
33. The EMD of successful bidder will be forfeited if agency do not execute the agreement within 7 days of issuance of work order and or does not start the work at site within 15 days of issuance of work order.
34. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within 28 days of the end of the bid validity period.
35. The Payment will be made as per actual work done at site as per C.S.R 2020 rates/N.S Rates approved by Competent authority. The rates shall be paid as per item rates, no through rate will be paid.
36. Processing fee will only be accepted through Net Banking (Direct Debit) and IPG (Credit/Debit card).
37. Bidders/Contractors/tenderers can access tender documents on the website mentioned above, fill them and submit the complete tender document into electronically on the website. Bidders/Contractors shall attach scanned copies of all the documents, i.e., Earnest Money, Processing Fee, Tender cost fee and certificates/documents as required in terms and conditions.
38. Agency should compulsorily upload the scanned copy of document such as:-
 - PAN No.
 - GSI No.
 - EPF No.
 - ESIC No.
 - Valid Enlistment Certificate
 - Self-Declaration that the contractor /L&C Societies / Firms have not been blacklisted till the publication of tender notice.
 - Identity proof
 - Capacity Certificate

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Section 0 – Invitation for Bids

Should be submitted in Technical Bid, in case of absence of any of the above documents, the bidder shall lose eligibility.

39. Bid Capacity:

The bid capacity of the prospective bidders will be calculated as under:

$$\text{Assessed Available Bid Capacity} = (A * N * 2 - B)$$

Where

A = Maximum value of Civil Engineering works executed in any one year (year means financial year) during the last five years (updated to the price level of the financial year in which bids are received at a rate per year as indicated in the BDS) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of the Project/Works for which these bids are being invited. (e.g. 7 months = 7/12 year)

B = Value (updated to the price level of the year indicated in B D S) of existing commitments (only allotted works) on the last date of submission of bids as per bidding document and on-going works to be completed during the period of completion of the Project/Works for which these bids are being invited.

Note: The statement showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be attached along with certificates duly signed by the Engineer-in Charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent. The contractor/Society also have to submit self-attested undertaking that the Society/Contractor is eligible to take part in the tender and has available bid capacity on the basis of above formula.

40. The bitumen price adjustment shall be paid using either the rates/prices prevailing at the time of intended date of completion, or the rates/prices as prevailing for the period under consideration, whichever is less.

41. For the MHI Covers which are buried under the road surface material and remain uncovered shall be charged @ Rs. 10000/- per MHI cover.

42. The bidder shall submit an undertaking that if he fails to sign contract in case the work is awarded to him or fails to submit performance security before as deadline defined in Tender Document or fails to complete work within time limit then their firm/the exemption for deposit EMD/Bid security under above clause cease for the time period decided by the competent authority.
