**General Terms and Conditions for Tenders**

- Interested bidders can purchase the tender documents online from website eproc.punjab.gov.in.
- Earnest money and tender cost fee shall be paid in online mode. Or As per latest notification/amendment dated 2.12.2025 of Punjab Govt. in Punjab Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2022 which is reproduced as.

**Bid submission:** "Bid Security and tender fee may be obtained in the form of insurance surety bonds, or bank guarantee (including e Bank Guarantee) issued or confirmed by any of the Scheduled Banks (as defined in section 2 (e) of the Reserve Bank of India Act 1934 or in the electronic format online (NEFT/RTGS/Internet banking) or any other online mode available on e-procurement portal. Bid security/EMD in the form of insurance surety bond or bank guarantee shall be submitted online only and insurance surety bonds or bank guarantee shall not be accepted in physical form. In case of exemption of Bid Security, the scanned copy of the document in support of exemption will have to be uploaded by the bidder during bid submission. For more information, the bidders shall refer to the instructions provided on the e-Procurement Portal's Website under Bidders Manual Kit.

Further, recognized Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs) and Startups are exempted from payment of Bid Security, Subject to submission of valid registration /Udyam certificate verified by the General Manager, District Industry Centre of the concerned district, confirming the units locations within Punjab and its MSE status or registered Startup with Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Punjab and must submit a Bid Security Declaration accepting that if they withdraw or modify their bids during period of validity, they will be suspended for the time specified in the tender documents"

"(c) Bid Security and tender fee may be obtained in the form of insurance surety bonds, or bank guarantee (including e Bank Guarantee) issued or confirmed by any of the Scheduled Banks (as defined in section 2 (e) of the Reserve Bank of India Act, 1934 or in the electronic format online (NEFT/RTGS/Internet banking) or any other online mode available on e-procurement portal. Bid security/EMD in the form of insurance surety bond or bank guarantee shall be submitted online only and insurance surety bonds or bank guarantee shall not be accepted in physical form.

(d) Further, recognized Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs) and Startups (recognized by the Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Punjab) are exempted from payment of Bid Security, subject to submission of valid registration or Udyam certificate verified by the General Manager, District Industries Centre of the concerned district, confirming the units locations of units within Punjab and its MSE status or registered Startup with the Department of Industries and Commerce, Government of Punjab and must submit a Bid Security Declaration accepting that if they withdraw or modify their bids during period of validity, they shall be suspended for the time specified in the tender documents"

3. Processing fee will only be accepted through Net Banking (Direct Debit) and IPG (Credit/Debit card).
4. Bidders/Contractors/tenderers can access tender documents on the website mentioned above, fill them and submit the complete tender document into electronically on the website. Bidders/Contractors shall attach scanned copies of all the documents, i.e., Earnest Money, Processing Fee, Tender cost fee and certificates/documents as required in terms and conditions.
5. Corrigendum/Addendum/Corrections, if any will be posted on the website only.
6. NIT and Terms and conditions have been/uploaded on website (eproc.punjab.gov.in.), agencies should note that online tenders should only be submitted at the aforesaid website eproc.punjab.gov.in as per the details/instructions uploaded therein.
7. NIT, Terms and conditions, NS rate details and specifications can be seen in the office of Municipal Corporation on any working day.
8. All legal proceedings in connection with the contract shall be subject to the territorial jurisdiction of the civil courts at Bathinda only.

9. For any other query bidders can contact the undersigned office on any working day.
10. The rates for payments shall be quoted above or below the CSR rates prevailing on date of tendering and current premium applicable and amendment issued by Govt. prevailing at the time tendering.
11. Agency should compulsory upload the scanned copy of document such as
  - (a) PAN No.
  - (b) GST No.
  - (c) EPF No.
  - (d) ESIC No.
  - (e) Valid Enlistment Certificate
  - (f) Self-Declaration that the contractor /L&C Societies / Firms have not been blacklisted till the publication of tender notice.
  - (g) Identity proof
  - (h) Capacity Certificate

Should be submitted in Technical Bid, in case of absence of any of the above documents, the bidder shall lose eligibility.
12. The tenders to the L&C Co-Operative Societies and Contractors will be issued and considered only if they produce an enlistment certificate from PWD (B&R) or any other Punjab Government Department in relevant category and class.
13. The tender to manufacturers/suppliers/authorized dealers who have successfully completed similar nature of works with satisfactory performance are exempted from above enlistment. However, they are required to meet the all other conditions of the DNIT.
14. The L&C Co-Operative Societies shall submit its capacity certificate from the concerned authority of Co-Operative department along with tender.
15. The contractor shall not remove any installed material from site of work without prior approval of CMC Bathinda.
16. The Contractor/Firms/ L&C Co-Operative Society must have got EPF code no. and ESIC prior to opening of tenders (As applicable).
17. The L&C Co-Operative Societies will have to submit a financial capacity certificate issued by Registrar, Co-Operative Societies. They will have to submit detail of their ongoing works in all departments. Works more than their financial capacity will not be allotted as directed by Director Local Govt. Punjab vide his letter No. 2123-24 dated 19.1.2021.
18. **Bid Capacity:**

The bid capacity of the prospective bidders will be calculated as under:

$$\text{Assessed Available Bid Capacity} = (A * N * 2 - B)$$

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A = Maximum value of Civil Engineering works executed in any one year (year means financial year) during the last five years (updated to the price level of the financial year in which bids are received at a rate per year as indicated in the BDS) taking into account the completed as well as works in progress.

N = Number of years prescribed for completion of the Project/Works for which these bids are being invited. (e.g. 7 months = 7/12 year)

B = Value (updated to the price level of the year indicated in B D S) of existing commitments (only allotted works) on the last date of submission of bids as per bidding document and on-going works to be completed during the period of completion of the Project/Works for which these bids are being invited.

**Note:** The statement showing the value of existing commitments and on-going works as well as the stipulated period of completion remaining for each of the works listed should be attached along with certificates duly signed by the Engineer-in Charge, not below the rank of an Executive Engineer or equivalent. The contractor/Society also have to submit self-attested undertaking that the Society/Contractor is eligible to take part in the tender and has available bid capacity on the basis of above formula.

19. If the Financial bid quotes more than 25% saving from the estimated cost, the Engineer may ask the bidder to produce detailed analysis for any or all the items to check the viability of rates w.r.t to Construction methodology & workability. After evaluation of price analysis, the ULB may ask the Bidder to give an additional Bank Guarantee of nationalized bank @ 5% of the estimated amount (to remain valid till the time period of the refund of security) so as to protect against financial loss in event of subsequent default by the Bidder for not completing the work etc.
20. The EMD of unsuccessful bidders shall be returned within 28 days of the end of the bid validity period.
21. The EMD of successful bidder will be forfeited if agency do not execute the agreement within 7 days of issuance of work order and or does not start the work at site within 15 days of issuance of work order.

**Other Terms and Conditions for Tender Item No. 1**

1. The rates quoted by the contractor/agency shall be deemed to be inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties, levies, cess, and statutory charges, including but not limited to GST, Labour Cess, and any other taxes imposed by Central/State Government or local authorities from time to time. No additional payment on account of such taxes/levies shall be entertained by the department.
2. The deployment of manpower shall be carried out by the contractor strictly as per the requirements of the department, on an "as and when required" basis, during the entire contract period. The contractor shall ensure timely availability of manpower as per directions issued by the competent authority, without any delay or excuse.
3. The quoted rates/percentage charges shall remain uniform and applicable across all categories of manpower. No variation in rates for different categories shall be permitted under any circumstances.
4. The contractor/agency shall strictly comply with all applicable labour laws, rules, and regulations. The agency shall discharge all statutory obligations on behalf of the Municipal Corporation, Bathinda, acting as Principal Employer, including but not limited to EPF, ESI, Labour Cess, Insurance, Medical benefits, GST/Service Tax, and other labour welfare legislations in force. Any liability arising out of non-compliance shall be solely borne by the contractor.
5. The categories of manpower shall be as under (or as per the latest Government Gazette/Notification issued from time to time):
  - **Highly Skilled:** Plumber Head, Mistry Grade-I, Security Guard etc.
  - **Skilled:** Supervisor, Driver, Electrician, Mason, Fitter, Clerk, Munshi, etc.
  - **Semi-Skilled:** Mali Senior, Mate/Mistry, etc.
  - **Unskilled:** Beldar, Helper, Mali, Sweeper, etc.
6. The contractor shall submit duly printed bills containing complete details, including Name of Agency, Address, Bill Number, GST Number, PAN Number, EPF Code, IFSC Code, and Bank Account Number. Incomplete bills shall not be accepted.
7. The contractor should submit EPF, ESI and Service Tax, Challan Copy along with bill or as applicable.



8. The rates shall be quoted in terms of percentage (%) above the prevailing DC rates. The bidder quoting the lowest percentage over and above the DC rates shall be declared as the L-1 (Lowest Bidder).
9. In case of any revision in DC rates or any statutory liabilities such as EPF, ESI, GST, etc., during the currency of the contract, the payment to the agency shall be regulated accordingly as per revised rates and applicable provisions.
10. In the event of failure by the agency to deposit statutory dues such as EPF, ESI, GST, Insurance, Medical benefits, etc., in the respective accounts within the stipulated time, appropriate legal and criminal proceedings shall be initiated against the defaulting agency as per law.
11. Any bid wherein the agency quotes 'NIL' service charges/consideration shall be treated as non-responsive and shall be summarily rejected without further evaluation.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR ITEM No. 2 For SUPPLY, INSTALLATION & COMMISSIONING OF LEVEL SENSOR/ENERGY SENSOR**

1. **Scope of Work:** The scope of work shall include the complete supply, installation, testing, and commissioning (SITC) of level sensors at designated locations as specified by the department. The contractor shall also carry out all allied works required for proper functioning of the system.
2. **Similar Nature Works:** Applicable to manufacturers, suppliers, authorized dealers, or contractors having successfully completed works of similar nature with satisfactory performance, duly supported by relevant documents and submit the same in technical bid having experience of SITC of minimum 10 nos. Of level sensors/energy sensor on one work value or 7 nos. In two works or 5 nos. In three works.
3. **Technical Specifications:** The level sensor and energy sensors to be supplied shall conform to the specifications prescribed by the department and relevant IS/IEC standards. The equipment shall be of reputed make and approved by the competent authority prior to installation.
4. **Supply of Material:** All materials, components, accessories, cables, fittings, mounting arrangements, and other consumables required for successful installation and operation shall be provided by the contractor and shall be included in the quoted rates.
5. **Installation & Erection:** The contractor shall carry out installation and erection work in a professional manner, ensuring proper alignment, safety, and compliance with site conditions. All civil, electrical, and mechanical works incidental to installation shall be included in the scope.
6. **Testing & Commissioning:** After installation, the contractor shall conduct complete testing and commissioning of the level sensor system in the presence of departmental representatives. The system shall be handed over only after satisfactory performance is achieved.
7. **Warranty/Guarantee:** The supplied equipment shall be covered under a minimum warranty period of 24 months (or as specified) from the date of successful commissioning. During this period, any defect or malfunction shall be rectified/replaced by the contractor at no extra cost.
8. **Maintenance Support:** The contractor shall provide necessary technical support during the warranty period and ensure smooth operation of the system. Preventive maintenance, if required, shall be carried out without additional charges.
9. **Completion Period:** The entire work shall be completed within the stipulated time period as mentioned in the work order. Delay in execution shall attract penalty as per applicable rules or as decided by the competent authority.
10. **Penalty Clause:** In case of delay in supply or improper installation, a penalty may be imposed as per departmental norms. Repeated failure may lead to cancellation of the contract and blacklisting of the firm.

11. **Safety Measures:** The contractor shall be responsible for ensuring all safety measures during installation work. Any accident or damage to property/person shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
12. **Payment Terms:** Payment shall be released only after successful installation, testing, and commissioning of the level sensor system and submission of all required documents, including invoices and completion certificate.
13. **Statutory Compliance:** The contractor shall comply with all applicable statutory requirements including GST, labour laws, insurance, and other applicable regulations. All liabilities shall be borne by the contractor.
14. **Inspection & Approval:** The material and work shall be subject to inspection by the department at any stage. Any defective or substandard material/work shall be rejected and replaced by the contractor at his own cost.
15. **Defect Liability:** Any defect observed during the defect liability period shall be rectified by the contractor within a reasonable time, failing which the department may get the work done at the risk and cost of the contractor.
16. **Termination Clause:** The department reserves the right to terminate the contract at any stage in case of non-performance, breach of terms, or unsatisfactory work without assigning any reason.
17. **Jurisdiction:** Any dispute arising out of this contract shall be subject to the jurisdiction of local courts at Bathinda only.
18. **Force Majeure:** Neither party shall be held responsible for delay or failure in performance due to unforeseen circumstances such as natural calamities, war, strikes, or government restrictions.
19. **Final Authority:** The decision of the competent authority of the department shall be final and binding in all matters related to this contract.

### GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR DNIT (Not for Press)

1	Electronic tenders shall be opened in the office of the Corporation Engineer in the presence of Contractors or their authorized representatives (if they wish) on the date and time prescribed in the tender notice.
2	If tender date happens to be a holiday, the technical and financial bid will be opened on the next working day. Regarding this, no separate publication in Newspaper/website will be given.
3	Free of Cost items, if quoted, shall be adjusted first or proportionally in payments as desired by the Engineer in charge.
4	Tax and other levies will be deducted from the contractor's bill as per rules.
5	DNIT and MW-4 shall be the part of the agreement.
6	Any or all tenders can be rejected by the competent Authority without assigning any reason.
7	Substandard materials will be rejected and shall not be payable.
8	For the supply items the goods bearing the ISI mark or the approved make or specified by M.C. will be the min. standard and F.O.R. at Municipal Corporation, Bathinda. Only BIS approved ISI marked paver blocks / interlocking tiles shall be used.
9	Conditional tenders shall not be accepted.
10	In case, department intends to get sample of works/materials tested from any laboratory, the cost will be borne by the contractor.
11	All running payments shall be considered as advance payments to the contractors and any excess payment in running bills shall be recovered from the contractor's next or final bill/security/EMD.
12	If any other type of tax (existing, new imposed by the Govt. and revised tax) during the execution of work, the same will be borne by the agency.
13	The unbalanced tenders shall be rejected.
14	(i) In case of any dispute or disagreement arising out of contract agreement Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Bathinda shall be the Sole Arbitrator, whose decision shall be final and binding upon both the parties. (ii) It shall be an essential term of this contract that in order to avoid frivolous claims, the party invoking arbitration shall specify the disputes based on facts and calculation stating the amount claimed under each claim and shall furnish a "deposit-at-call" for ten percent of the amount claimed, on a scheduled bank in the name of the arbitrator by his official designation who shall keep the amount in deposit till the announcement of the award. In the event of an award in favour of the claimant, the deposit shall be refunded to him in proportion to the amount awarded with respect to the amount claimed and the balance, if any, shall be forfeited and paid to the other party.
15	Rates quoted by the contractor inclusive all types of taxes, octroi, royalty and levies etc.
16	Quoted tender should be as per enlisted class by the individual contractor otherwise it shall be invalid.
17	Security deducted will be refunded after 1 year from the date of completion.
18	In case of supply material, 5% security will deducted and the same will be refunded after 1 month from the date of completion of supply order.
19	All the traffic arrangements including diversion, barricading shall be provided by the agency at its own cost along with the required security persons. The Municipal Corporation shall not pay extra for it.

20	10% security shall be deducted from each bill of the contractor.
21	The tenders to the L&C Co-Operative Societies and Contractors will be issued and considered only if they produce an enlistment certificate from PWD (B&R) or any other Punjab Government Department in relevant category and class.
22	The L&C Co-Operative Societies shall submit its capacity certificate from the concerned authority of Co-Operative department along with tender.
23	The agency shall not remove any installed material without prior approval of CMC Bathinda
24	The Societies / Contractors shall abide by Punjab Roads & Bridges Development Board letter No. 8623-40 Dt. 11.10.2018 and Chief Engineer, Local Government End. Letter No. EIC-19/28590-605 Dt. 24.6.2019 where ever applicable.
25	For Interlocking tiles / any construction material municipal officials can visit at source site for interlocking tiles / any construction material can check and get tested material to be supplied.
26	In case of administrative approval cost/final cost of any work is Rs. 10.00 lacs and above, third party Techno Financial Auditors shall be engaged. Deduction @0.8% + applicable GST (or the rate quoted by third party Techno Financial Auditor) whichever is less shall be made from the payments of the contractor.
27	The R/A bill payment shall be released after recommendation of subcommittee formed by House.
28	The Societies / Contractors shall abide by Chief Engineer, Local Government Punjab Letter No. CE-2025/16509 Dt. 28.03.2025 (copy attached) where ever applicable.
29	<p><b>The following instruction should be followed for the electrical works/supply orders: -</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tenders relating to new installation/repair electrical works will be considered contractors/firms having valid license from Chief Electrical Inspector, Patiala.</li> <li>2. Tender relating to electrical work will be considered only, if the bidder must quotes make of the supply of fittings and attach their scanned copy of authorization certificate issued from the company.</li> <li>3. Municipal Corporation may ask firm to furnish original invoice of purchase/supply items of manufacturing goods/company goods.</li> <li>4. The supply of LED street lights should be as per specifications issued by Technical Advisor vide letter no.
